If you see an "Inspected by" label on a headlamp, don't be worried that it may be a prior return, instead know that one of our team members has checked to be sure you are getting a new, undamaged part.

- Keep your battery charged: If your car is idle for extended periods, consider using a battery maintainer or trickle charger to prevent deep discharge.
- Replace aging batteries proactively: Car batteries typically last 3-5 years, but heat can shorten this lifespan.

## Auto Insurance Trends Report: Collision Severity Decreases, Rate Hikes Easing

The 2025 U.S. Auto Insurance Trends Report from LexisNexis Risk Solutions reveals that rates increased by 10% in 2024, down from a 15% rise in 2023. This report analyzes 2024 data on consumer driving patterns, claim frequency, and insurance shopping trends.

#### Key findings include:

- Despite a 9.2% increase in bodily injury severity and a 2.5% rise in property damage severity, collision severity decreased by 2.5%, signaling improved safety.
- Driving violations rose significantly, with major speeding violations up 16% and distracted driving violations increasing by 50%.
- Policy shopping reached an all-time high, with over 45% of policies shopped by year-end.
- The market is softening, allowing some insurers to fill for rate decreases, as direct written premiums grew 13.6% to \$359 billion.
- Transitioning to electric vehicles (EVs) brought a 14% rise in claim frequency due to higher repair costs.

Jeff Batiste from LexisNexis noted that as insurers adapt to a changing market, those who can accurately assess trends and adjust pricing will have a competitive edge.


